

**PASSENGER FEEDBACK ON PROPOSED *FIXED ROUTE* FARE ADJUSTMENT  
PROPOSAL – NOVEMBER 2011**



**REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS:**

- New electronic fareboxes arriving soon
- Eliminate confusion for regional passengers using CAT and DATA systems by aligning fare structure with others in region
- Decrease farebox maintenance costs and confusion associated with transfer ticketing

**Description of Fare Adjustments:**

- No change to base fare of \$1 per one way trip (half price for disabled)
- Free rides for Seniors (Age 65 or Older or already approved C-Tran Seniors age 60 to 64)) 12 and younger ride free, too
- New \$2 Day Pass (eliminates need for free transfers unless traveling one-way on two routes)
- New 5-Day Pass for \$8.50 replaces current 11-Ride Pass for \$8
- New 31-Day Pass (good from date activated) for \$36 replaces current
- \$30 Monthly Pass
- All new passes will be available for Certified disabled riders at half price
- No proposed fare changes on Door-to-Door service

**PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE IS JANUARY 3, 2012. ALL CURRENT C-TRAN TICKETS WILL BE GOOD THROUGH THE END OF FEBRUARY 2012.**
